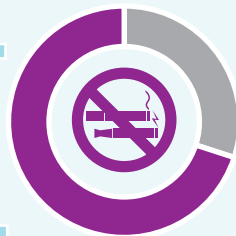
Strong public support observed among West Hollywood residents for smoke-free multi-unit housing policies.

(e.g., Balconies, patios, etc.)

50%

Outdoor Common Areas

(e.g., courtyards, pools, etc.)

This report presents public opinion survey data collected in the City of West Hollywood between March 10, 2019 through March 15, 2020.

380 residents completed the survey, representing persons of varied sex, age groups, racial/ethnic groups, and tobacco use status.

This survey is based on a convenience sample of West Hollywood residents, and may not reflect the views of all residents.

21% of respondents are current tobacco users (n=78) & 79% of respondents are non-tobacco users (n=302).
